World AIDS Day 2025, under the theme "Overcoming disruption, transforming the AIDS response", calling for sustained political leadership, international cooperation, and human-rights-centered approaches to end AIDS by 2030.

You can only get HIV by coming into direct contact with certain body fluids from a person with HIV who has a detectable viral load. These fluids are:

- ✓ Blood
- ✓ Semen (cum) and pre-seminal fluid (pre-cum)
- ✓ Rectal fluids
- ✓ Vaginal fluids
- ✓ Breast milk

Fact Sheet About HIV



KEY FACTS ABOUT HIV:

- ✓ HIV remains a major global public health issue, having claimed an estimated 44.1 million lives to date. Transmission is ongoing in all countries globally.
- ✓ There were an estimated 40.8 million people living with HIV at the end of 2024, 65% of whom are in the WHO African Region.
- ✓ In 2024, an estimated 630 000 people died from HIVrelated causes and an estimated 1.3 million people acquired HIV.
- There is no cure for HIV infection. However, with access to effective HIV prevention, diagnosis, treatment and care, including for opportunistic infections, HIV infection has become a manageable chronic health condition, enabling people living with HIV to lead long and healthy lives.
- ✓ WHO, the Global Fund and UNAIDS all have global HIV strategies that are aligned with the SDG target 3.3 of ending the HIV epidemic by 2030.

GLOBAL IMPACT

By 2025, 95% of all people living with HIV should have a diagnosis, 95% of whom should be taking lifesaving antiretroviral treatment, and 95% of people living with HIV on treatment should achieve a suppressed viral load for the benefit of the person's health and for reducing onward HIV transmission.


